This ERISA case is before the Court on the parties' Joint Motion for Entry of Protective Order [51-1]. The proposed Protective Order seeks to protect certain categories of documents exchanged in discovery from public disclosure. For the reasons that follow, the parties' motion is denied without prejudice. ?In the context of requests for protective orders covering discovery materials, courts are primarily concerned with determining whether good cause has been shown to deny the public access to portions of the court record. Citizens First National Bank of Princeton v. Cincinnati Ins. Co., 178 F.3d 943, 945 (7th Cir. 1999) (emphasizing that "[t]he judge is the primary representative of the public interest in the judicial process and is duty-bound therefore to review any request to seal the record (or part of it)."). In this case, the parties have agreed that it is preferable to make a good cause determination for filing under seal if and when the parties seek to file documents or information under seal. Paragraph 7 of the proposed Protective Order states that all Confidential documents or information "shall be filed in the public case file unless the producing party

		obtains a court order specifically requiring that such documents or information be filed under seal." The parties' approach makes a ruling on the proposed Protective Order unnecessary at this time. This approach is also eminently sensible and may save judicial resources because only a small subset of all discovery is ever filed in the public record or used during a court proceeding. In fact, the full Court of this district is currently considering an amendment to Local Rule 26.2 to provide that court authorization is required before a particular document may be filed under seal. See http://10.205.15.104/LEGAL/CHGTORULES/Lcr_2.pdf . The Advisory Committee for Local Rules anticipates that "the amendment will discourage parties from being overly-generous in designating documents to be filed under seal." Id. Having said all of this, the Court notes that the parties have agreed amongst themselves in paragraph 6 of the proposed Protective Order to limit disclosure of Confidential Material to certain specified persons and not to disclose or permit disclosure of such material to any other person or entity. See <i>In re Bridgestone/Firestone, Inc. v. Bridgestone/Firestone Inc., et. al.</i> , 198 F.R.D. 654, 657 (S.D. Ind. 2001) (noting "[a]ccess to discovery materials when those materials have been presented to the court is one issue and quite another issue when the parties are exchanging the materials amongst themselves."). The Seventh Circuit has recognized that "[a]bsent a protective order, parties to a law suit may disseminate materials obtained during discovery as they see fit." <i>Jepson, Inc. v. Makita Electric Works, Limited</i> , 30 F.3d 854, 858 (7th Cir. 1994). "In other words, if they do not see fit to disseminate discovery information, the parties need not do so." <i>In re Bridgestone/Firestone, Inc.</i> , 198 F.R.D. at 657; <i>Baxter International, Inc. v. Abbott Laboratories</i> , 297 F.3d 544, 545 (7th Cir. 2002) (stating "[s]ecrecy is fine at the discovery stage, before the material enters the judicial record"). A confidentiality agreement amongst the parties regarding the categories of information they seek to protect from public disclosure will sufficiently address their concerns at this stage of the litigation and there is no need for court approval or intervention regarding such an agreement. See <i>Taffinger v. Bethlehem Steel Corp.</i> , 2001 WL 1287625, at *3 (E.D. Pa. Oct. 24, 2001) (noting that "the parties have the option of agreeing privately to keep information concerning the Defendant's personnel records confidential, and may enforce such an agreement in a separate contract action.").
